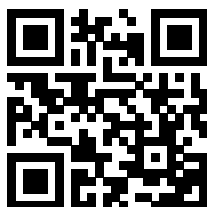

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BURGLARY PROTECTION ELECTRONIC AND MECHANICAL MEASURES

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A burglary usually lasts between 5 and 10 minutes.



A burglar most commonly uses a screwdriver to force a window.

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In the event of a burglary, call immediately the Police emergency number.



ELECTRONIC PROTECTION

THE ALARM SYSTEM



A wireless alarm system can easily be installed at a later date by a professional company. For new buildings, a wired alarm system is recommended.

The alarm system is individually programmable for each property and its inhabitants and should include the following elements:

- Central alarm unit with internal siren
- External siren on the front side of the house (clearly visible)
- Alarm transmitter (GSM module)
- Magnetic contacts (door, garage door) with integrated shock sensors on windows
- Motion detector
- Camera / doorbell with camera
- Glass break detector
- Smoke detector

The alarm system also needs to be activated if you are leaving the house for a short time. In addition, the alarm system can be programmed so that you can move freely in your home.



CAUTION :
Video surveillance should only be used on your private property.

Any form of **video material** may be very **useful for subsequent** Police investigations.



LIGHTING

Burglars avoid light. Especially in autumn and winter, when the days are shorter and the nights longer, it is advisable to use electronic timers to light the inside of your house.

MECHANICAL PROTECTION

DOORS

The Police recommend installing a burglar-resistant entrance door in accordance with **DIN EN 1627** with a minimum resistance class of **RC2**.

The door glazing should comply with the **DIN EN 356** and be fitted with at least laminated glass resistance class **P4A**.

In an apartment building and in the cellar, the security of the existing door can be reinforced with a crossbar or an additional lock.

WINDOWS

For new constructions or renovations, burglar-resistant windows of resistance class **RC2** according to **DIN EN 1627** should be installed as a minimum.

Triple glazing does not make break-ins more difficult if no laminated safety glazing of resistance class **P4A** according to **DIN EN 356** has been installed.

Existing windows can be strengthened with additional screw-on security devices.

CELLAR WINDOWS, GRILLES AND ROLLER SHUTTERS

Cellar windows (or light wells) can be reinforced with stable steel sheet panels or secured with grids.

Roller shutters and blinds are generally designed to provide protection against light and prying eyes.

However, a double-walled aluminum profile with a rigid foam core makes it more difficult to cut or tear off the shutters. In addition, an anti-lift device can be installed.
